
#### First Woman Veteran Elected to Lead VFW:

Career Army veteran Carol Whitmore was elected as the new national commander of the VFW at the 126th VFW National Convention held this year in Columbus, Ohio. "I may be the first veteran to have been elected VFW commander-in-chief while wearing a dress ... but I will NOT be the last! ... I am your comrade by mud, by blood, by dust, by dirt, by sand, by land, by sea, by air ... I am a veteran first!" said Whitmore. Initially enlisting in the Women's Army Corps in 1977, she earned her VFW eligibility by serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom. Throughout her 36 -year military career, she received the Legion of Merit Medal, Bronze Star Medal, Army Commendation Medal (six), Iraq Campaign Medal and the Combat Action Badge, among many others. She joined the VFW in 2012 at Post 9127 in Des Moines, Iowa, where she maintains her Gold Legacy Life membership.


